Refund Policy:

Refund of unused portions of tuition, fees, etc. if student does not enter course Students will be refunded the full course costs if they are unable to attend the desired course and have given at least a 7-day notice to Dive Alaska LLC. Full tuition refunds are allowed if cancelled over one week before the start of the course. Tuition is non-refundable if cancelled within one week before the course. For individuals doing any of the programs, this policy is in effect for the individual sections as opposed to the program as a whole (i.e., Open Water, Advanced Open Water, Rescue, Divemaster). Refund amount will be calculated by the remaining courses untaken. Once a section has been started, no refunds can be given for that section.

For students who voluntarily leave during a program or are dismissed by Dive Alaska for any reason during the progression of the course will be refunded a pro-rated amount based on last day of attendance.

Refund Due Dates:

- 1. If an applicant never attends class (no-show) or cancels the contract prior to the class start date, all refunds due will be made within 30 calendar days of the first scheduled day of class or the date of cancellation, whichever is earlier.
- 2. For an enrolled student, the refund due will be calculated using the last date of attendance and be paid within 30 calendar days from the documented date of determination. The date of determination is the date the student gives written or verbal notice of withdrawal to the institution or the date the institution terminates the student, by applying the institution's attendance, conduct, or Satisfactory Academic Progress policy.

Cancellations:

- 1. Rejection of Applicant: If an applicant is rejected for enrollment by an institution, or if a prospective international student has his/her visa application rejected, a full refund of all tuition paid will be made to the applicant.
- 2. Program Cancellation: If an institution cancels a program after a student's enrollment, the institution will refund all monies paid by the student or transfer the money to the next course at the discretion of the student and paying party. In event of transfer, a new Enrollment Agreement will be signed.
- 3. Cancellation After the Start of Class: An institution may consider a withdrawal as a cancellation or no show (for example, within the first week of the program) provided this process is fully delineated in writing as part of the refund policy and provided to all students at or before enrollment. A student who is considered a cancellation or no show under such a policy will be refunded a pro-rated amount based on entire courses not yet completed. This includes students who are dismissed from the course for unsatisfactory performance.

Instructor Program Refund Policy

A student cancelling enrollment before the start of class and students withdrawing after class starts will be refunded any unused portion of the tuition, fees, and other charges. The charges to the eligible person for tuition, fees, and other charges will not exceed the approximate pro—

rata portion of the tuition, fees, and other charges that the length of the completed portion of the course bears to the total length of the course. Dive Alaska will have 30 days after withdrawal or termination to pay any refund due. All programs are subject to change, lack of availability or cancellation without notice.
